Christmas, A Promise Fulfilled The Power of Hope

I. Hope Has an Object

1 Peter 1:3-4 (NIV[®])

³ Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us **new birth into a living hope** through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, ⁴ and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade--kept in heaven for you,

2 Corinthians 1:10 (NIV®)

On him we have set our hope that he will continue to deliver us,

1 Timothy 6:17 (NIV[®])

¹⁷ Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to **put their hope in wealth**, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment.

II. Christmas ---God's eternal purposes become visible

A. God's purposes are not an interruption!

- Sometimes they are personal events ---Mary
- Sometimes they are events which you are invited to observe ---Shepherds
- Sometimes they are events in which you can play a role ---Joseph

B. Christmas Lessons

III. Prophecy, Hope & the Holy Spirit

Acts 1:6-8 (NASB[®])

⁶ So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, "Lord, is it at this time You are restoring the **kingdom to Israel?**" ⁷ He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or epochs which the Father has fixed by His own authority; ⁸ but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

1 Corinthians 1:23 (NIV®)

²³ but we preach Christ crucified: a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles,

John 8:32-35 (NIV®)

Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." ³³ They answered him, "**We are Abraham's descendants** and have never been slaves of anyone. How can you say that we shall be set free?" ³⁴ Jesus replied, "I tell you the truth, everyone who sins is a slave to sin. ³⁵ Now a slave has no permanent place in the family, but a son belongs to it forever.

IV. Lessons in Hope

A. Hope relates to the future, faith is now

Hebrews 11:1 (NIV®)

1 **Now faith is** being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.

B. Wrestling with Despair (hopeless)

Psalm 25:1-5 (NIV[®])

¹ To you, O LORD, I lift up my soul;

- ² in you I trust, O my God. Do not let me be put to shame, nor let my enemies triumph over me.
- ³ **No one whose hope is in you will ever be put to shame**, but they will be put to shame who are treacherous without excuse.
- ⁴ Show me your ways, O LORD, teach me your paths;
- ⁵ guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and **my hope is in you all day long**.

C. Hope has a partner ---perseverance

Romans 8:24-25 (NASB[®])

For in hope we have been saved, but hope that is seen is not hope; for who hopes for what he *already* sees? ²⁵ But **if** we hope for what we do not see, with perseverance we wait eagerly for it.

Hebrews 10:35-36 (NIV[®])

³⁵ So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded. ³⁶ **You need to persevere** so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised.

D. Hope is about your mind, will & emotions

Hebrews 6:19-20 (NIV[®])

- ¹⁹ **We have this hope as an anchor for the soul**, firm and secure. It enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain, where Jesus, who went before us, has entered on our behalf. He has become a high priest forever, in the order of Melchizedek.
 - 1 Thessalonians 5:8 (NIV®)
- ⁸ But since we belong to the day, let us be self-controlled, putting on faith and love as a breastplate, and **the hope of salvation as a helmet**.

E. Hope strengthened through expression

Hebrews 10:23 (NASB[®])

²³ Let us hold fast **the confession of our hope** without wavering, for He who promised is faithful;

Hebrews 3:1 (NASB®)

¹ Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the Apostle and **High Priest of our confession**;

PRAYER:

Heavenly Father, I rejoice today in the great gift of Your son Jesus. In Him I have life and hope. In this season may Your provision for me be more real than any need I face. Direct my steps that I may share Your gifts of Christmas with those I meet. Give me discernment to see beyond myself and see the opportunities around me. May the hope of Jesus flow through my life this week. Almighty God in You I put my hope and trust. Amen.
