I. God's Anger: The Refusal to Honor the Lord

Lamentations 2:1-6, 21-22 (NIV®)

How the Lord has covered the Daughter of Zion with the cloud of his anger, in the day of his anger! v.1

Without pity ... in his wrath he has torn down the strongholds of the Daughter of Judah. v.2

In fierce anger ... He has withdrawn his right hand at the approach of the enemy. v.3

... he has poured out his wrath like fire on the tent of the Daughter of Zion. v.4

The Lord is like an enemy; he has swallowed up Israel. v.5

... in his fierce anger he has spurned both king and priest. v.6

²¹ "Young and old lie together in the dust of the streets; my young men and maidens have fallen by the sword. **You have slain them in the day of your anger; you have slaughtered them without pity.** ²² "As you summon to a feast day, so you summoned against me terrors on every side. In the day of the Lord's anger no one escaped or survived; those I cared for and reared, my enemy has destroyed. **vs. 21-22**

II. Learn the Character of God

Ecclesiastes 12:13-14 (NASB®)

The conclusion, when all has been heard, is: fear God and keep His commandments, because this *applies to* every person. For God will bring every act to judgment, everything which is hidden, whether it is good or evil.

A. God is Not Like Us!

Job 36:26 (NIV[®])

How great is God—beyond our understanding!

Psalm 90:2 (NIV®)

Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

Hebrews 1:10–12 (NIV®)

¹⁰ He also says, "In the beginning, O Lord, **you laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands**. ¹¹ They will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like a garment. ¹² You will roll them up like a robe; like a garment they will be changed. But **you remain the same, and your years will never end**."

Psalm 102:24–28 (NIV®)

²⁴ So I said: "Do not take me away, O my God, in the midst of my days; your years go on through all generations. ²⁵ In the beginning **you laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands**. ²⁶ They will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like a garment. Like clothing you will change them and they will be discarded. ²⁷ But **you remain the same, and your years will never end**. ²⁸ The children of your servants will live in your presence; their descendants will be established before you."

B. We Can Learn God's Ways

Exodus 33:13 (NIV®) (Moses)

If you are pleased with me, teach me your ways so I may know you and continue to find favor with you.

Leviticus 10:10-11 (NIV®)

¹⁰ You must distinguish between the holy and the common, between the unclean and the clean, ¹¹ and you must teach the Israelites all the decrees the Lord has given them through Moses."

1 Corinthians 3:1–3 (NIV®)

¹ Brothers, I could not address you as spiritual but as worldly—mere infants in Christ. ² I gave you milk, not solid food, for you were not yet ready for it. Indeed, you are still not ready. ³ You are still worldly.

Hebrews 5:14 (NIV®)

But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil.

III. Honoring the Lord is the Best Choice!

Honoring the Lord is Both an Attitude & an Activity

Proverbs 3:9-10 (NIV®)

⁹ Honor the Lord with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops; ¹⁰ **then** your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine.

Jesus, Worthy of Honor

John 5:23 (NIV®)

... He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent him.

Revelation 5:12 (NIV®)

In a loud voice they sang: "Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!"

Honoring God in Our Homes

Exodus 20:12 (NIV®)

Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the Lord your God is giving you.

Matthew 15:4 (NIV®)

For God said, 'Honor your father and mother' and 'Anyone who curses his father or mother must be put to death.'

An Esteem Bestowed by God

Proverbs 15:33 (NIV®)

The fear of the Lord teaches a man wisdom, and humility comes before honor.

Proverbs 22:4 (NIV®)

Humility and the fear of the Lord bring wealth and honor and life.

Proverbs 29:23 (NIV®)

A man's pride brings him low, but a man of lowly spirit gains honor.

The Final/Ultimate Reward of Righteousness

John 5:44 (NIV®)

How can you believe if you accept praise from one another, yet make no effort to obtain the praise (honor) that comes from the only God?
