#### **Application Point**

## **Conversation Stations**

Sit with the children during Conversation Station time and discuss the three Connection Questions.

#### **Conversation Station Options:**

- 1. Construction Play
- 2. Giant Road Playmat w/Cars
- 3. Wood Puzzles
- 4. Coloring Sheet



#### **Connection Questions:**

- 1. Where is a quiet spot in your house?
- 2. Do you like going to that quiet spot?
- 3. Does God like it when we talk to Him?



## Group Activity Time

Group Activity Time provides an active learning experience to review lesson concepts.

#### Option #1 – Sardines

What you need: A large open space

**What you do:** This game is played opposite of "Hide and Seek." Choose one child to hide while the rest of the children cover their eyes. At your signal, the children will look for the hidden child. When they find him, they can hide with him. Choose another child to hide and play again.

**What you say:** In our story today we learned that Jesus found a quiet spot to talk to God. He went to a spot away from his friends. Did they know where He was? They had to look for Him, didn't they? Can you think of a special spot in your house where you can talk to God?

#### Option #2 – Find the Spot

What you need: Black construction paper circle

**What you do:** The teacher or child hides the circle somewhere in the room while one child hides his or her eyes in the corner. The rest of the children give clues such as "hot," "hotter," or "cold," "colder" to the child searching. Play until all the children have had a turn.

**What you say:** In our story today we learned that Jesus found a quiet spot to talk to God. He went to a spot away from his friends. Did they know where He was? They had to look for Him, didn't they? Can you think of a special spot in your house where you can talk to God?

#### **Option #3 – Where is Jesus?**

What you need: A large sheet or blanket

**What you do:** Lay the sheet or blanket on the floor and have the children sit around the edges. Choose one child to step away from the group and stand facing the corner with his or her eyes closed. Choose another child to climb under the sheet. The child that was away from the group comes back to guess who is hiding as the rest of the children sing (to the tune of London Bridges).

Who snuck off to talk to God? Talk to God, Talk to God. Who snuck off to talk to God? Guess who's missing?

#### **Prayer Spot Sign**

#### Supplies:

- Cardstock
- 9"x12" construction paper (various colors)
- Glue
- Embellishments (ie. glitter, sequins, string)
- Markers/crayons
- Yarn or ribbon (18" piece per child)
- Hole punch



#### **Directions:**

- 1. Have each child color the sign and write their name on the line.
- 2. Glue the sign onto construction paper.
- 3. Decorate the sign as desired with embellishments.
- 4. Punch holes in the top corners. Tie the yarn on each corner to create a way to hang the sign.



#### **Read the Story!**
