Lead With Faith The Valley of Decision

World Outreach Church Sermon Discussion Guide Sunday Sermon: **October 30, 2022**



God's people are walking in a valley of decision, at a pivot or tipping point, and I believe our choices in the months ahead will have a great deal to do with what our future looks like. The hearts of God's people will determine our future more than any earthly thing, whether political or financial. I am not denying those things are powerful, but they pale in comparison to the power of Almighty God, Creator of Heaven and Earth. His power is greater than anything we depend on in the world, and the hearts of God's people determine God's involvement in the earth. We are the people of God on assignment in this world for a very brief season, entrusted with spiritual authority as ambassadors for the King—and decisions are being made that will determine outcomes that our children and our grandchildren will know. I. NOT A NEW PROBLEM

Perversion

Isaiah 5:20–23 ²⁰ Woe to those who call evil good and good evil, who put darkness for light and light for darkness, who put bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter. ²¹ Woe to those who are wise in their own eyes and clever in their own sight. ²² Woe to those who are heroes at drinking wine and champions at mixing drinks, ²³ who acquit the guilty for a bribe, but deny justice to the innocent.

Revelation 22:11 "Let him who does wrong continue to do wrong; let him who is vile continue to be vile; let him who does right continue to do right; and let him who is holy continue to be holy."

Truth & Honesty Rejected

Psalm 52:3 You love evil rather than good, falsehood rather than speaking the truth.

Isaiah 59:14–15 ¹⁴ So justice is driven back, and righteousness stands at a distance; truth has stumbled in the streets, honesty cannot enter. ¹⁵ Truth is nowhere to be found, and whoever shuns evil becomes a prey. The Lord looked and was displeased that there was no justice.

Deception

Matthew 24:4–5 ⁴ Jesus answered: "Watch out that no one deceives you. ⁵ For many will come in my name, claiming, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many."

Matthew 24:11 ... and many false prophets will appear and deceive many people.

Philippians 4:9 Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.

Acts 5:27–33 ²⁷ Having brought the apostles, they made them appear before the Sanhedrin to be questioned by the high priest. ²⁸ "We gave you strict orders not to teach in this name," he said. "Yet you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching and are determined to make us guilty of this man's blood." ²⁹ Peter and the other apostles replied: "We must obey God rather than men! ³⁰ The God of our fathers raised Jesus from the dead—whom you had killed by hanging him on a tree. ³¹

God exalted him to his own right hand as Prince and Savior that he might give repentance and forgiveness of sins to Israel. ³² We are witnesses of these things, and so is the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him." ³³ When they heard this, they were furious and wanted to put them to death.

Isaiah 57:20–21 ²⁰ But the wicked are like the tossing sea, which cannot rest, whose waves cast up mire and mud. ²¹ "There is no peace," says my God, "for the wicked."

Philemon 1:9–11, 17-18 9 I then, as Paul—an old man and now also a prisoner of Christ Jesus— 10 I appeal to you for my son Onesimus, who became my son while I was in chains. 11 Formerly he was useless to you, but now he has become useful both to you and to me. . . . 17 So if you consider me a partner, welcome him as you would welcome me. 18 If he has done you any wrong or owes you anything, charge it to me.
