



This past weekend, we had the pleasure of hearing from actor, writer, and producer, Kirk Cameron. He is boldly using his influence to stand for the Lord and to advocate for children and families across the nation and around the world. He shared how true reformation of our culture will only come from the Church bravely and unapologetically proclaiming the gospel in our homes, our communities, and beyond.

Cameron is known by millions as “Mike Seaver” from the sit-com “Growing Pains.” Since then, he starred in the movies “Fireproof,” “Left Behind” and “Monumental,” and produced the film “Lifemark” about the value of life in the womb and the beauty of adoption. He also produced the documentary, “The Homeschool Awakening,” and hosts TBN’s television series, “Takeaways with Kirk Cameron” and “One-on-One with Kirk Cameron.” His “American Campfire Revival” livestream, events, and podcast, urge the family of faith to return to the principles that will bring blessing and protection to America. He most recently authored the children’s book, “As You Grow” that teaches Biblical principles and character.

### **Discussion Questions:**

1. Where have you seen an attack on the hearts and minds of our children in today’s culture?
2. What would it look like for you to intentionally join in the fight to win back the hearts and minds of our children?
3. What can we learn from the story about Alfred, the King of Wessex? How does it make you feel to know that one person boldly sharing the gospel can change the trajectory of a community and beyond?
4. Kirk posed the question, what if the past three years specifically have not been a national setback, but a divine set up for a spiritual comeback for the family of faith? How does this encourage you to reform your home, workplace, community, etc.?
5. We have been called to be *reformers* and not just *reporters*. When have you found yourself passively complaining about our culture? How can you shift your thinking to being more focused on boldly and bravely standing for the Lord in your sphere of influence—starting at your kitchen table?
