Psalm 146:3–10 (NIV84)

- ⁹ The LORD watches over the alien and sustains the fatherless and the widow, but he frustrates the ways of the wicked.
- ¹⁰ The LORD reigns forever, your God, O Zion, for all generations. Praise the LORD.
