WEEK ONE

October 5 to October 11, 2024

WE WILL NOT STOP STANDING FOR THE CHILDREN!

The children are our responsibility. We have an assignment to guide, shepherd, protect, and parent them—whether we have children in our households, or not. An important component of this is to continually lift them up in our prayers.

DAY 1

Almighty Lord, deliver us from every expression of evil intended to disrupt Your purposes for our families and our homes. We ask for positive and encouraging relationships to take root in each child's life, and that they will act in ways that attract and promote godly friends and relationships. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 2

Heavenly Father, please forgive us for being distracted and silent regarding the unborn. You created each child for such a time as this, in Your appointed place, for a special plan and purpose. Give us a new boldness and courage to help save future children from the danger of abortion. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 3

Lord, Your Word is filled with miraculous accounts of protection. Put a hedge of protection around each child as they engage in this world. Protect their minds wherever they go, and let Your presence guide them with discernment. The plans You have for them are plans of good and not evil, plans of prosperity and not calamity, plans that give them a future and a hope. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 4

Almighty God, our children are entering a world with unprecedented turmoil. We know Your warnings and promises never fail. May we lead the children with alertness and help them keep their eyes on You. We plead for godly leaders and teachers who will strengthen and equip the children with boldness and truth. We pray for wise teachers that will plant Your Word early on. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 5

Father, give us new hearts that are more receptive, understanding, and aware of what You are doing in those around us. Give us the boldness to be identified as Your people, with a willingness to take Your truth into our homes and to our children. Grant each child continual opportunities to grow in knowing You. May their lives be fruitful, from the beginning to end. Help them always be led by the Holy Spirit, aligning their hearts, attention, and words to Your wisdom. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 6

Almighty God, we celebrate the freedom of the cross and pray that each child would grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord at a young age. We know our children are a significant part of what You are doing in the earth. We pray that they will know You personally, love You, and desire to follow You all their lives. Give them hearts that are submissive and obedient to You. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 7

Heavenly Father, give the children an awareness of the value they have in Your sight. Forgive us for not caring about Your principles and values, for being silent, and for those places where we have denied You. We pray You give each child the ability to discern right from wrong, so their lives are godly and upright before You. Help them to obey and honor You, walking in a way that pleases You. In Jesus' name, amen.

WEEK TWO

October 12 to 18, 2024

WE WILL NOT STOP PRAYING FOR THE PEACE OF ISRAEL!

The Bible tells us to pray for the peace of Israel, Jerusalem, and the Jewish People. After all, without the Jewish people, we would have no faith, no prophets, no Bible, and no Messiah. Our assignment is to pray for the absence of conflict, and that they would recognize Jesus—the Prince of Peace—as their Messiah

DAY 1

Heavenly Father, we pray for the peace of Jerusalem. May her inhabitants dwell in safety. Open the eyes of the people to their King, and secure those who love You. May peace dwell richly within their land. Only You are worthy and able to bring stability to that region. We thank You that You watch over us, and You never slumber or sleep. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 2

Almighty God, we pray for the relationship of the United States with Israel. Keep Your hand upon it, guide our interactions and policies, and overrule anything that does not honor You and Your people. Do not allow our nation to turn against Israel or to take its stand amongst the enemies of Israel. Instead, graciously use this nation to continually support Your people and the nation of Israel. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 3

Lord, thank You for the Jewish people and those using their voices to stand with Israel. We fervently pray against any form of antisemitism in our nation and our world. Convict the hearts of those who harbor hatred and ill will against the Jewish people. Silence those who are making wicked and ungodly choices against Your people. May their plans fail, their schemes unravel, and may the truth be exposed and brought to justice. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 4

Heavenly Father, provide protection and bring joy to Israel during the heaviness of this season. We pray for all the hostages in Gaza—comfort them and their families. Lord, give them strength, courage, and freedom from the enemy. Bring hope to their souls, peace to their minds, and deliverance to their lives. Safely return them home to their families. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 5

Almighty God, You are the only One who can provide comfort and healing to those in Israel and Gaza. Remove the veil from the eyes of the Jewish people so they may come to know Jesus as their Messiah. Help them turn their hearts toward You and repent as they recognize their eternal salvation relies on their faith in Jesus. Let the gospel touch the hearts of all so they can experience the peace of Your presence now and forever. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 6

Lord, we ask You to supernaturally protect Your chosen people. Empower them. Provide for them. Guard their cities and their borders. Secure the lives and livelihoods of those who love You. May Your peace extend throughout their borders, and allow it to dwell richly in every heart that calls on You. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 7

Almighty Lord, thank You for those who serve in the Israeli military, their families, and the tremendous sacrifices they are making. Give wisdom and strength to the leaders. Bless them. Look upon Jerusalem and bring peace. You are their hope and deliverer. May the name of Jesus be exalted in the land. We fervently pray for Israel's borders, the military, and their families. In Jesus' name, amen.

WEEK THREE

October 19 to 25, 2024

WE WILL NOT STOP SEEKING THE LORD!

Spending consistent time with God anchors us in His Truth, and reminds us of how He calls us to live and who we are in His eyes.

DAY 1

Heavenly Father, You have called us out of darkness. You have established us in righteousness. You have sanctified us. Forgive us for grumbling about the difficulty of the journey and failing to believe in Your great strength. We repent of our stubborn unbelief. We choose to follow You with our whole hearts. We will not stop! In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 3

Almighty God, teach us to love Your truth. Grant us a revelation and an insight into Your Word, that we may understand how to walk in Your righteousness. Your Word is a weapon against Satan. Teach us to take hold of the Bible's authority through every arena of our lives. We proclaim Your Word is true, and we ask that You make it alive in our lives. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 4

Father, You have called us out of darkness and established us in the Kingdom of Your Son. We yield our lives to You without reservation. May our days be pleasing in Your sight. Deliver us from temptation. Establish us in Your strength and provision, that we may Honor the One who has saved us. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 5

Heavenly Father, if there's anything within us that's displeasing or a limit to You, we pray You will make it clear to us. You have called us to be a part of Your body in this season, and to stand for Your truth and righteousness. In all our flaws and weaknesses, and all that we are not, we thank You that in Christ Jesus, we are wholly adequate. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 6

Lord, we praise You that You have included us in Your kingdom, our sins have been forgiven, and we have been declared “not guilty” in Your sight. Thank You that we are children of the King. You are worthy of all glory, honor, and praise. Blessed be the name of the Lord. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 7

Almighty God, thank You for Your great provision for our lives. You have not left us alone or uncared for, but have made us participants in Your eternal purposes. You have called us out of the darkness. Help us to walk in the light and choose paths of righteousness. Deliver us from evil and restore the joy of our salvation. In Jesus’ name, amen.

WEEK FOUR

October 26 to November 1, 2024

WE WILL NOT STOP — PERSEVERANCE

Resolve to intentionally know God by seeking Him, following Him, praying to Him, and reading His Word. Each day offers new strength, new hope, and new opportunities to say “yes” to the Lord.

DAY 1

Oh Lord, who keeps His covenant of love with all who love Him and obey His commands, we have sinned and done wrong. We have been wicked and rebelled. We have turned away from Your commands and laws. We have not listened to Your direction. Hear the prayers and petitions of Your servants. Look with favor on Your people and forgive us. In Jesus’ name, amen. (derived from Daniel 9)

DAY 2

DAY 3

Almighty God, You welcome those who seek You and respond to them with expressions of grace and mercy. We are a people in need of healing; we have pursued our agenda while neglecting Yours. We have enjoyed abundance for which others have sacrificed. Respond to us from Your compassion; Your judgments are justified and righteous. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 4

Heavenly Father, You did not give us a spirit of timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline. Look on America with mercy. Do not respond to us according to our choices, but from Your heart of grace. We have been ungrateful and unholy. Awaken Your people to righteousness and purity. Give us boldness to stand for the truth, no matter the cost. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 5

Heavenly Father, forgive us for choosing our ways and our culture’s lies instead of Your ways and Your truth. Let revival come, and let it begin with us. We pray for courage to take the name of Jesus into our neighborhoods, schools, and businesses. Let revival come to us, our family, and our nation. In Jesus’ name, amen.

DAY 6

O Lord, we forgive everyone who has wronged us. We release them, in Jesus' name. We ask You to forgive us of every time we have sinned against You. If there is anyone we need to forgive, bring it to our minds, that we can release them. We thank You for the freedom that comes when we choose to forgive. In Jesus' name, amen.

DAY 7

Almighty God, we want to yield to the Lordship of Jesus, offering ourselves as living sacrifices. Forgive us for placing our will before Your will. Help us to learn to say "yes" to You. Grant us understanding hearts and the courage to follow You. May the words of our mouths and the meditations of our hearts be pleasing in Your sight. In Jesus' name, amen.

WEEK FIVE

November 2 to 8, 2024

WE WILL NOT STOP PRAYING FOR OUR NATION!

Our nation's foundations were built on Judeo-Christian principles. The Lord is One who provides our freedoms. He is the source of life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. We need a government and a Church that fears the Lord.

DAY 1
